The Northville boys cross country team competed last Friday on a cool night at Oxford Hills Golf Club in Oxford, Mich.

The Mustangs, running their 'B' squad, finished 4th of 16 teams in the varsity competition.

"We like to challenge our kids and put them up against true varsity competition," Northville coach Tim Dalton said. "A lot of these kids are the future of our team, and races like this helps them be better prepared when their time comes to be called up into the varsity lineup."

Freshman Brian McCallum was the top finisher for the Mustangs taking 20th overall in 16:58.21.

Rochester Hills Stoney Creek won the meet with 41 points, followed by Lake Orion (84), Oxford (93), Northville (130) and Rochester Adams (130).

Andrew Nolan of Lake Orion finished first in the 5-kilometer race in 15:51.72.

Other Northville finishers were senior Jack Spangler, 23rd (17:05.57), junior Alex Beloiu, 24th (17:05.59), sophomore Matt Krahe, 25th (17:08.53), junior Adrien Jund, 39th (17:18.16), freshman Peyton McCaslin, 42nd (17:25.52), and junior Grant Gattoni, 60th (17:45.16).

"There were some good times and good races," Dalton said. "We showed that we've got good depth and we're going to carry this momentum to the conference championship meet next week."
